How does TheraBlue Night work?

One part of the coating stack filters out the yellow light between 565 and 595 nm which reduces light glare from the various light drivers encounter. It also improves color contrast and sharpens vision in low light. In addition, it helps reduce light sensitivity and fights eye strain. The other part of the coating is a high quality Anti-Reflective Coating which further reduces glare.
